## 8,000+

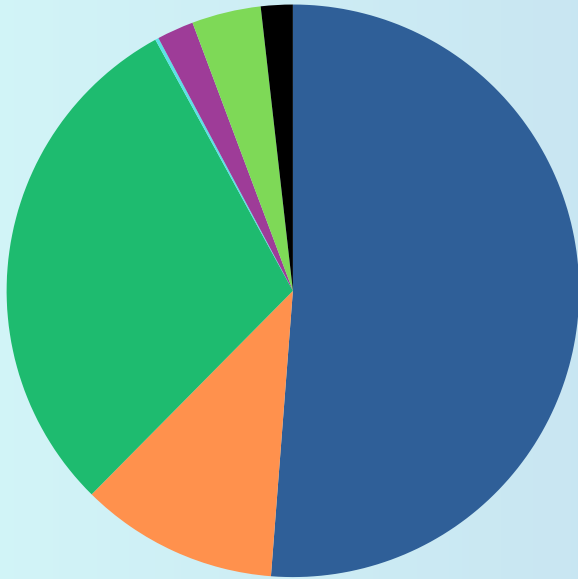
Over 8,200 people served in our clinics, residences, day programs, and community services.

- Fundraising & Other

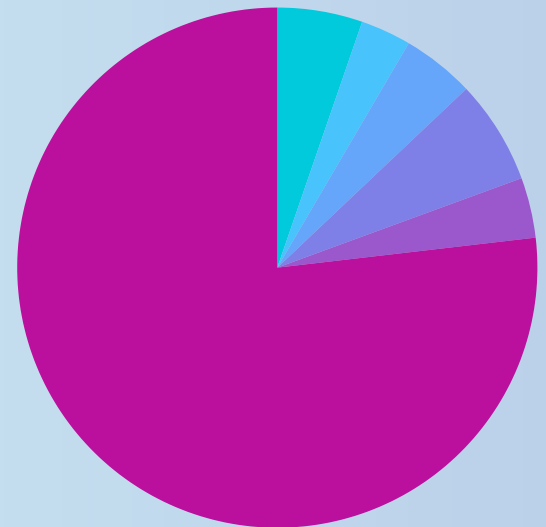


88% of all agency expenses incurred go directly to the individuals we serve
